

## Sanctus Booklet

Print on heavy paper, or even cards stock to make a durable booklet.

One of the first page should be printed for each child. You will then need an extra hosanna page for each child, which can be printed using the page with four hosanna's on it.

Suggestion: Hole punch one side and fasten with brass brads. Each week pass out the new page, color and add to booklet. Older students can learn all the words, younger students can just focus on the bold/outlined word meanings.

Most translations are easy to follow. The following may help:

Pleni sunt **Caeli** et terra Gloria Tua.

Full are heaven and earth (with) glory yours.

Hosanna can be translated roughly to mean "Glory and honor." We don't really have an English word, which is probably why we say Hosanna, even in the translation!

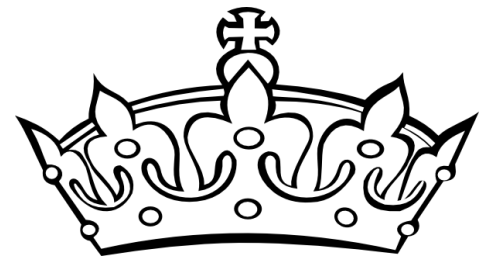
