

# David



David was the youngest of several sons of Jesse. One of the most famous Bible stories is about David and Goliath. When he was just a boy helping tend sheep, the Philistines and the Israelites were fighting over territory. The battle was at a standstill, neither side progressing, when a giant stepped out from the Philistines and offered to end the war with one man to man battle. To end a war with just a man to man battle could save a lot of people from death, but the giant Goliath was so huge and scary that there were no volunteers to fight him. David was bringing supplies to his brothers who were in the Israelite army, when he heard of this challenge. With just a sling, a few rocks, and great faith in God, David defeated Goliath and ended the war.

David was also one of King Saul's closest friends, and is often shown playing the harp. When King Saul was tormented by evil spirits, David would play his harp or lyre to soothe him and drive away the evil. Saul grew angry at David and jealous of God's favor of David and tried many times to have him killed. David was great friends with Saul's son, Johnathan. Johnathan often helped David escape from Saul's attempts to kill him. Saul and his sons died and eventually David became king. He made Jerusalem into a great city.

David displeased God later on by stealing another man's wife. He sent Uriah into battle, and when he was slain, David took Uriah's wife Bathsheba as his own. God punished David by allowing his first son from Bathsheba to die. But David had another son, Solomon, whom God loved. When David died, after 40 years of ruling, Solomon became king of Israel.

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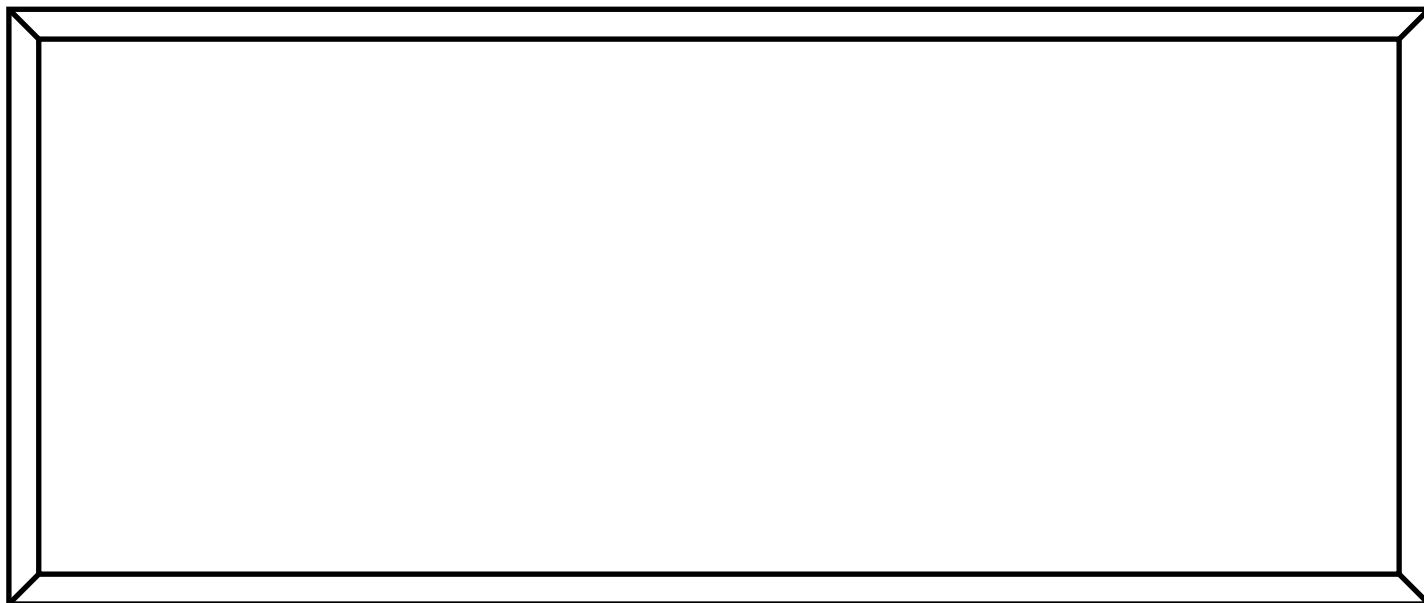
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Draw a picture of David and Goliath or a picture of you overcoming your fears through trust in God

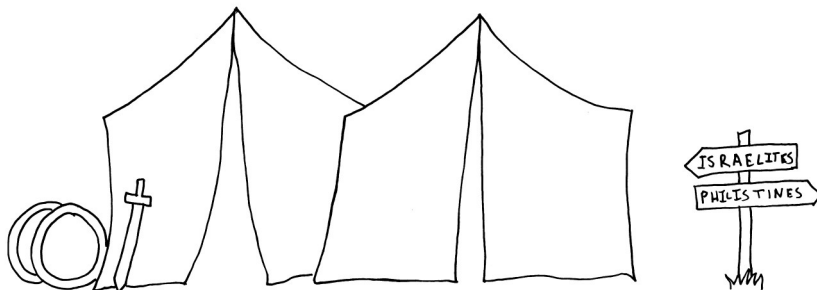
Help David travel to the Israelite army by following the path divisible by 8.

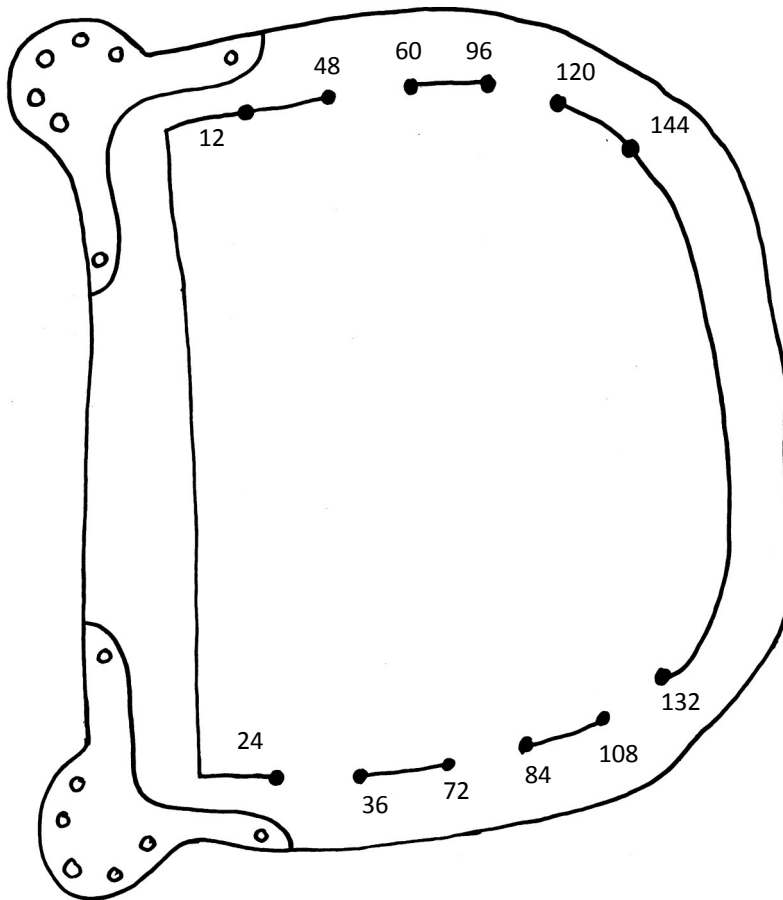
