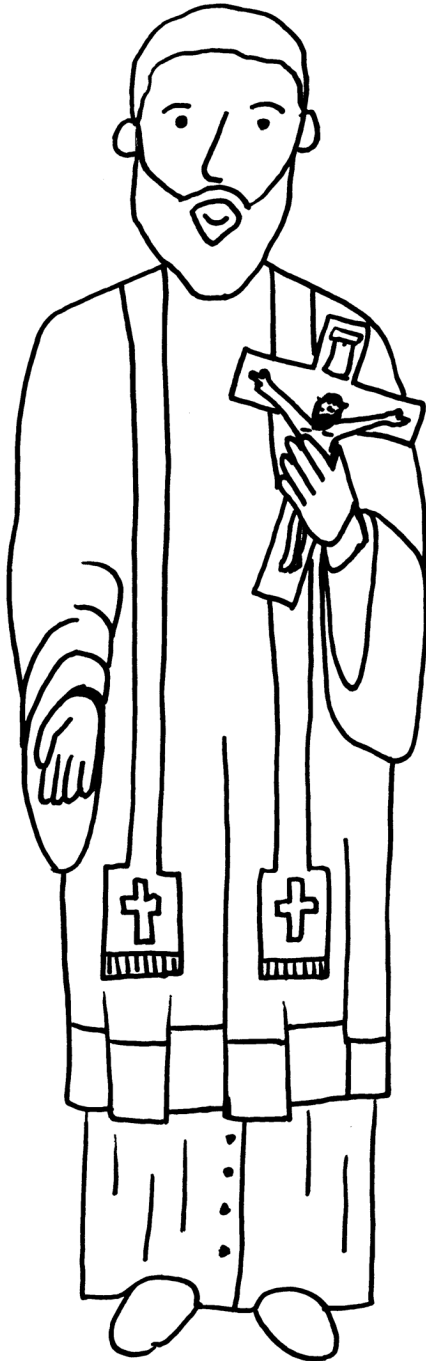


Saint Francis Xavier

Saint Francis Xavier was born in his family's castle in Spain. He studied some in Spain, but later moved to Paris, France to continue his studies. When he was in Paris, he met Saint Ignatius of Loyola, and along with several other men created the Society of Jesus, or Jesuits. He along with Saint Ignatius of Loyola made a vow of poverty in 1534. Then just a few years later, in 1537 he was ordained a priest.

Saint Francis Xavier was a teacher for a while, but later moved to Vince, Italy where he worked in hospitals and cared for the sick. He found out he had a real passion for caring for the ill. He traveled far and wide preaching the gospel and helping the sick in hospitals. Much of his work was in India, and the Asian islands. He spread the gospel in Malaysia and then went to Japan, where he learned enough Japanese to teach them about Christ and baptism. Saint Francis Xavier wanted to travel to China next to share the good news, but he never made it there. He got very sick and died on the island of Sancian, only 100 miles from Hong Kong in China.

Saint Francis Xavier is the patron saint of foreign missions. His feast day is December 3rd.

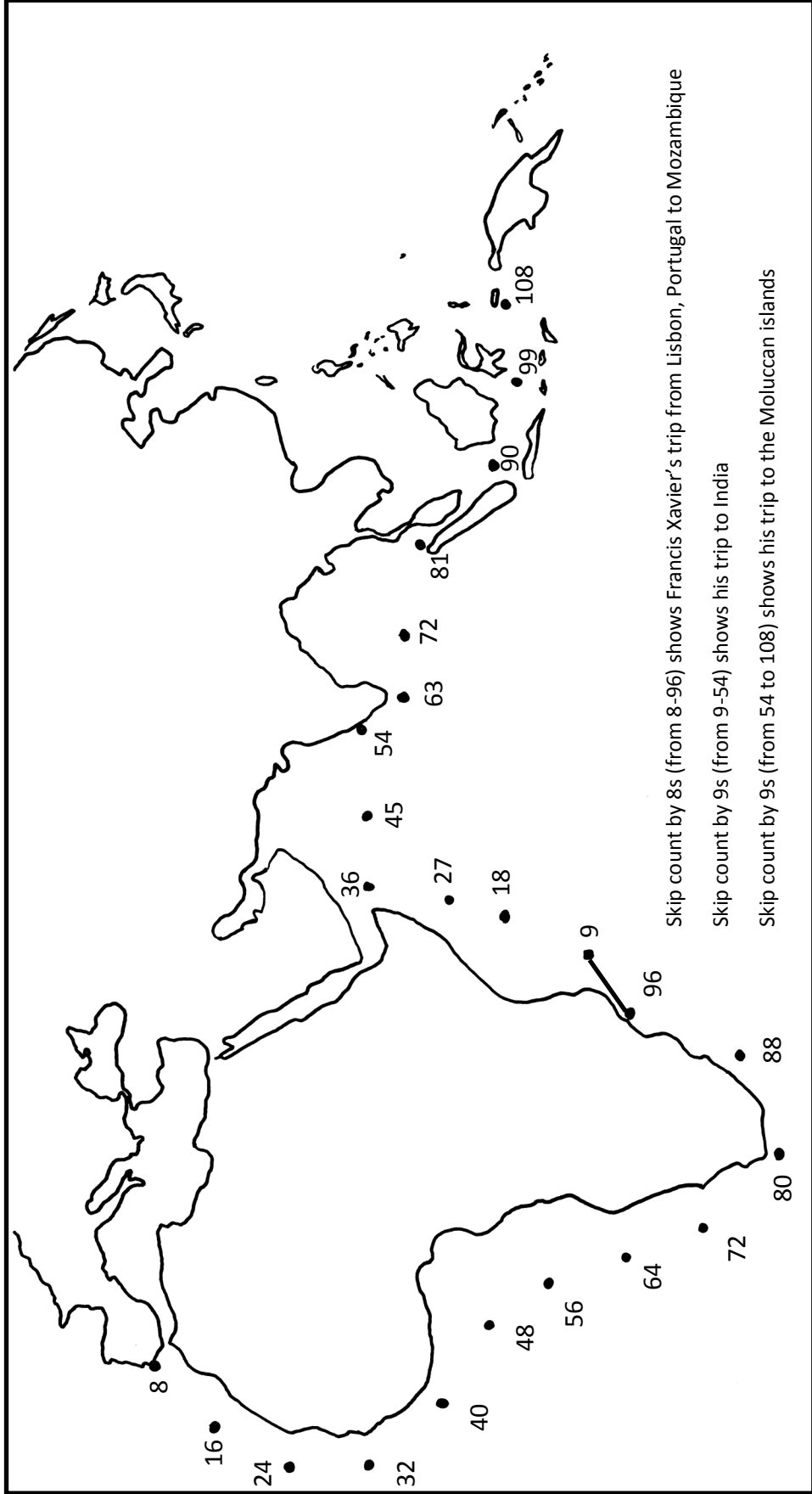

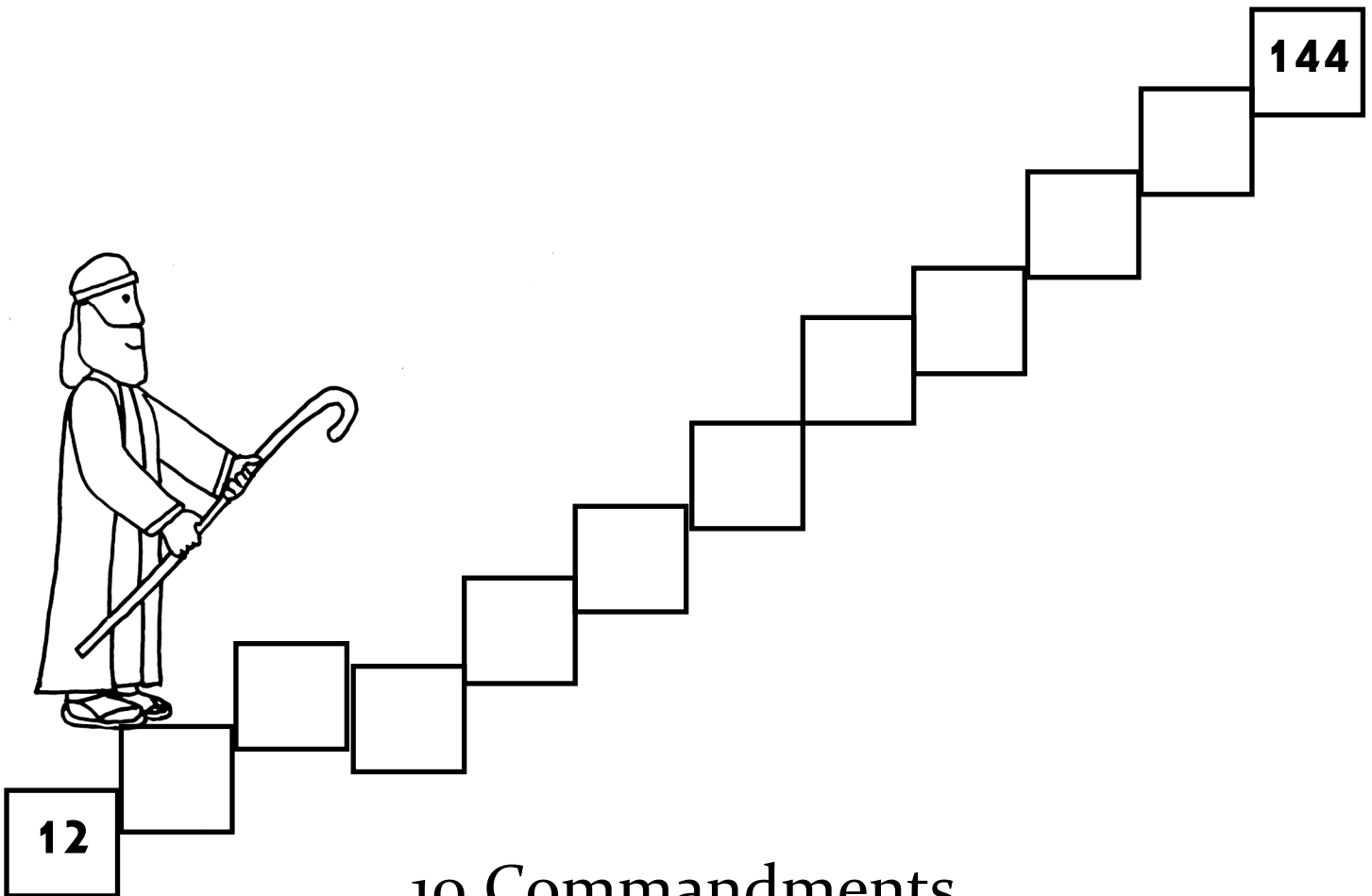
