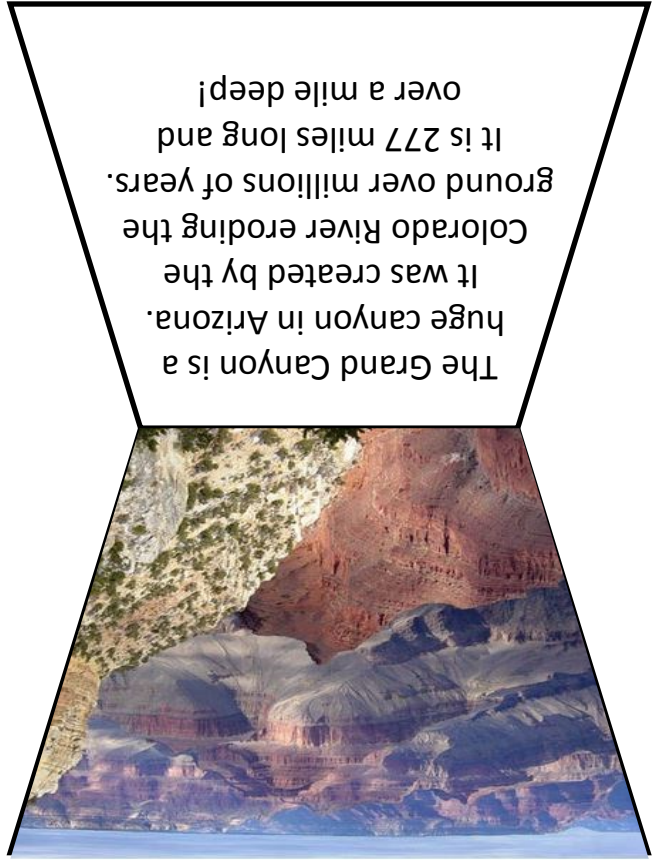


Mount St. Helens is an active volcano in Washington State. It is famous for a huge and deadly eruption in 1980 which even blew off a portion of the mountain, creating a large horse shoe shaped crater.



The Grand Canyon is a huge canyon in Arizona. It was created by the Colorado River eroding the ground over millions of years. It is 277 miles long and over a mile deep!



The Yukon River begins in Canada and flows into Alaska where it empties into the Bering Sea. It is 1,980 miles long and was an integral part of transportation during the Klondike Gold Rush the 1890's.



The Columbia forms the border between Washington State and Oregon. It is the longest river in the Pacific Northwest at 1,243 miles long! It is extremely scenic and has many waterfalls that flow into it!
